Refunds will be given if class is cancelled due to lack of minimum participants. Bad weather dates will be offered if class is cancelled due to poor driving conditions.

# Please Be Advised;

- Facility **hours are from 7:30 am to 8:30 pm**. Office staff hours vary.
- If you are stabling overnight you may **check in your horse no earlier than noon the day before the clinic**. Horses must be **out by 6pm or 2 hours after the last ride**. (Special stabling arrangements must be made by calling the office in advance)
- There is **NO SMOKING** in any of the barn areas
- **Clean up after your horse** in; grooming, loading, arena, and turn out areas.
- **You are in charge of bringing your own feed and feeding during the clinic**. For a fee of \$5 PER FEEDING 8th heaven staff will feed hay twice (AM/PM), as well as, one bag of pre-mixed and labeled grain per day (AM.)
- **No trailers allowed in the immediate barn area**. Please use the trailer turn around.
- **Use of the stall runs is at the risk of the horse owner/agent**

## Obstacle Course Rules

- **Do not attempt an obstacle without staff supervision**
- **Do not wander off on your own** or away from the group.
- **Use obstacle only for it's intended purpose.**
- **We highly recommend the use of a helmet** for all riders (helmets are **required for all those under 18 years old.**)
- Individual obstacles are always optional, **do all obstacles at your own risk.**
- **You must first complete a "Confidence and Reliability Clinic" before you may participate in the "Trusting Partner Trail Course."**
- **We maintain the right to ask you not to attempt any or all obstacles if we feel you are not ready or it might be unsafe for you, your horse or others around.**
