Roger Kyle's many years as a trainer for the Denver Police Mounted Patrol provided him the opportunity to develop a better understanding of equine behavior and a variety of insights to facilitate the dialogue between horse and human.

This is a 2 day clinic that is great for all levels of horses and rider to get you started on the right track. This clinic is designed to improve communication between and the confidence of both the horse and the rider. The first day of this clinic is all from the ground and focuses on; Understanding your horse in hand, Planning and preparation for approaching difficult obstacles and leaving obstacles, Learning to anticipate your horse's movement and reacting appropriately. The 2nd day is under saddle (if the rider feels ready) you will work on applying the

principles learned the first day under saddle in a ways to ensure success. Throughout this clinic the rider and horse will be given tools to assist them in overcoming problem they may come across in the future. For horses too young to be under saddle or for other reasons, you may choose to participate on day 1 for \$150 and participate on day 2 for \$150 at a later clinic in order to qualify for completion. School horses are available for an additional fee. A minimum of 6 participants is required for clinic to be held. Refunds will be given if minimum participation if not met. Alternate dates will be offered for cancelation due to poor driving conditions.

Note: Only registered riders and auditors are allowed in the clinic arena. Young riders under 16 may bring one adult supervisor.

Please Be Advised

- ❖ Facility **hours are from 7:30 am to 8:30 pm.** Office staff hours vary.
- ❖ If you are stabling overnight you may **check in your horse after noon the day before the clinic.** Horses should be **out by 6pm or 2 hours after the last ride.** (Special stabling arrangements must be made by calling the office in advance)
- ❖ There is **NO SMOKING** in any of the barn areas
- ❖ **Please clean up after your horse** in; grooming, loading, arena, and turn out areas.
- ❖ **You are in charge of bringing your own feed and feeding during the clinic.** For a fee of \$5 Per Feeding; 8th Heaven staff will feed hay twice (AM/PM), as well as, one bag of pre-mixed and labeled grain per day (AM or PM)
- ❖ **No trailers allowed in the immediate barn area.** Please use the trailer turn around.
- ❖ **Use of the stall runs is at the risk of the horse owner/agent.**
